The village festival, Notre Dame des Neiges in January, the Lavender Festival, accompanied by the many musical events organized by the various associations, as well as the petanque competition in August, are the highlights of this very dynamic mountain village.

Ascent of the summit of Baudon, Mont Ours, the peak of Siricocca and Gramondo l'Everest of the bay of Menton, allows the discovery of a breathtaking panorama of the Alps and the Mediterranean.
