

LA POINTE DU SIRICOCCA ET LE COL DE VERROUX



Explore this 10.1 km loop route.

Generally considered a difficult route, it takes an average of 3 h 45 min to travel.

It is a popular route for hiking, but you can still enjoy some moments of tranquility.

The best time to visit is from December to October.

DISTANCE:

10.1 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

564 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

3 H 45 MIN

Loop



This hike starts north of Sainte-Agnès, at the Saint-Sébastien Chapel and passes among others by the Col de Verroux (935 m) and the Pointe du Siricocca (1058 m).



SAINTE-AGNÈS - CASCADE DU BORRIGO



Discover this 7.1 km loop route considered difficult.

It takes an average of 2 h 55 min to complete.

This route is ideal for hiking.

You will not meet many people because of its difficulties.

Accessible all year round, this circuit is worth it in any season.

DISTANCE:

7.1 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

481 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

2 H 55 MIN

LOOP



A hike between sea and mountain from Sainte-Agnès.

This route is mostly in the woods and passes through the waterfall of Borrigo. From Sainte-Agnès, you will have great views of the city of Menton and the Mediterranean Sea.

In the village you can also see the military fort of the Maginot line and the remains of the medieval castle.



COL DES BANQUETTES DE SAINTE-AGNÈS



This 4.7 km round trip is considered a moderate route.

It takes an average of 1 hour and 40 minutes.

It is a popular place for hiking and running, so you will likely come across some hikers on your trip. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a leash.

DISTANCE:

4.7 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

243 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

1 H 40 MIN

ROUND TRIP



The route begins next to the chapel of Saint-Sébastien and goes up to the Col des Banquettes at 736 m altitude.

This route stretches between the Pointe du Siricocca (1058 m) and the Cime de Baudon (1265 m).



CIRCUIT DU MONT OURS



Discover this 12.9 km loop route.

Obviously a difficult journey!

It takes an average of 4 h 50 min to complete.

This is a popular route for hiking and mountain biking, but you can still enjoy some moments of tranquility. You can access it all year round and this course is accessible in any season.

DISTANCE:

12.9 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

736 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

4 H 50 MIN

LOOP



The route passes among others by the Col de Verroux (935 m), the Pic de Garuche, the Mont Ours (1239 m) and near the Col des Banquettes (736 m).



COL DE BAUSSON SINCE SAINTE-AGNÈS



Take a look at this 5 km loop route.

A moderate route, which you will complete on average in 1 h 47 min.

This hike is ideal for walking, and you will certainly not meet many people on the trails.

Accessible all year round and in any season, this circuit remains interesting!

Dogs are welcome and may be released in certain locations.

DISTANCE:

5 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

259 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

1 H 47 MIN

LOOP



The route passes through the Col de Bausson (792 m) and the Saint-Sébastien Chapel, before returning to the starting point.



CIME DE BAUDON SINCE SAINTE-AGNÈS



A 5.8 km round trip is considered a difficult route, it takes an average of 3 h 12 min to complete.

It is a route suitable for hiking or you can even enjoy some moments of tranquility.

DISTANCE:

5.8 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

628 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

3 H 12 MIN

ROUND TRIP



The route passes through the Pas de la Piastre (921 m) and the Cime de Baudon (1265 m), before returning to the starting point.



CHÂTEAU SAINTE-AGNÈS - CASCADE DU BORRIGO



Feel free to explore this 6.6km round-trip itinerary.

Evaluated as a difficult course, it takes an average of 2 h 39 min to complete.

It is a popular route for hiking and walking, where you can enjoy some moments of tranquility.

The best time to visit is from February to October. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a leash.

DISTANCE:

6.6 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

421 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

2 H 39 MIN

ROUND TRIP



The route passes through the Pas de la Piastre (921 m) and the Cime de Baudon (1265 m), before returning to the starting point.



SAINTE-AGNÈS, POINTE DU SIRICOCCA, PIC DE GARUCHE



Walk this 14.5 km loop route, generally considered difficult.
This uncrowded route is ideal for hiking.
The best time to visit is from February to October.

DISTANCE:

14.5 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

900 M

LOOP



The route includes the Saint-Sébastien chapel, the Pas de la Piastre (921 m), the Col des Banquettes (736 m), the Pic de Garuche, then the Col de Verroux (935 m) and the Pointe du Siricocca (1058 m), before returning to the starting point.



COL DE VERROUX



Explore this 7.9 km round-trip route, which some consider a difficult one.

It will take an average of 3 hours to travel.

It is a popular route for hiking, but you can still enjoy some moments of tranquility.

DISTANCE:

7.9 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

467 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

3 H

ROUND TRIP



The route passes near the Col des Banquettes at 736 m altitude, then through the Col de Verroux (935 m), before returning to the starting point.

This route goes around below the Pointe du Siricocca (1058 m).



SAINTE-AGNÈS - LE RAY



Take a look at this 3.4 km round-trip route. Generally considered to be moderate, it takes an average of 1 hour and 27 minutes to complete. Suitable for running and walking, you can nevertheless enjoy some moments of tranquility.

You can access it all year round and in any season.

Dogs are welcome and may be released in certain locations.

DISTANCE:

3.4 KM

STEEPNESS OF ELEVATION:

243 M

ESTIMATED TIME:

1 H 27 MIN


